The prime objective of Novo is to develop the culture, protocols and procedures to maintain and enrich relationships with key stakeholders.

To achieve this Novo will:

- Seek to carry out activities in a manner that will minimise impact to cultural heritage.
- Comply with regulatory and ethical standards relating to cultural heritage.
- Respectively engage and consult with the Traditional Owners and Indigenous people to ensure cultural issues are treated in an appropriate and sensitive manner.
- Develop workforce awareness of the importance of Cultural Heritage and provide a workplace where Indigenous people feel welcome.
- Provide practice and promote a positive personal attitude to Cultural Heritage by providing information and training.
- Have continuous improvement through ongoing assessment of our performance including addressing and resolving grievances.

This policy will be reviewed at least annually.
